

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF TIOGA, TEXAS MAKING IT UNLAWFUL TO DISCHARGE ANY FIREARMS, AIR GUNS OR B-B GUNS WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS OF THE CITY OF TIOGA. PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY FOR VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TIOGA, TEXAS:

SECTION ONE

DISCHARGE OF WEAPONS. It shall be unlawful to discharge any firearm or airgun, beebie gun, or any toy gun, projecting lead or any missiles excepting in a regularly established shooting gallery; provided that this section shall not be construed to prohibit any officer of the law from discharging a firearm in the performance of his duty; nor to any citizen from discharging a firearm when lawfully defending person or property.

SECTION TWO

PENALTY. Any person, or corporation violating any provision of this ordinance shall be fined not less than five dollars nor more than five hundred dollars and a separate offense shall be deemed committed on each day during or on which a violation occurs or continues.

SECTION THREE

EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall become effective after publication by the City Secretary as required by law.
