

ORDINANCE NO. 230

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NUMBER 167; SETTING THE FEE FOR A SEWER TAP AND ADDING THE COSTS INVOLVED IN ANY ADDITIONAL WORK SUCH AS ROAD BORES TO SEWER TAP FEES FOR CONNECTING RESIDENCES OR BUSINESSES INSIDE THE CITY LIMITS OF THE CITY OF TIOGA TO THE CITY SEWER SYSTEM; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS the City Council of the City of Tioga has determined that the cost of installing a sewer tap may increase in instances where additional work, such as boring and/or street cutting and repair are required; and

WHEREAS it is in the best interests of the City that the fees for sewer tap to the city sewer system be increased when additional work is required beyond the normal tap work; and that such increase be effective upon passage of this Ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TIOGA, TEXAS;

SECTION 1

From the Date of passage of this Ordinance, Ordinance No. 167 is hereby amended to read that the fee for tapping a sewer line for service to a resident or business customer inside the city limits shall be \$750.00 plus the actual cost of any additional work that may be required including, but not limited to, road bores or extra deep trenching.

SECTION 2

The tap fee due to the City of Tioga must be paid to the City prior to connection to the City water system.

SECTION 3

Authority to enforce this Ordinance shall be vested in the Mayor or his/her assign or agents.

SECTION 4

If any Section or part of any Section or paragraph of this Ordinance is declared invalid or unconstitutional for any reason, it shall not invalidate or impair the validity, force or effect of any other Section or Sections or part of a Section or paragraph for this Ordinance.


SECTION 5

SECTION 7


All Ordinances and parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
