

ORDINANCE NO. 250

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF TIOGA, AMENDING ORDINANCE NUMBER 157, COMMONLY REFERRED TO AS THE SUBDIVISION ORDINANCE, SECTION F, 1 AND 2, PROVIDING FOR THE PLACEMENT OF FIRE HYDRANTS.

**WHEREAS**, the City of Tioga, Texas (the, "City") is a Type A General Law City; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council has investigated and determined that it will be advantageous, beneficial, and in the best interest of the citizens of Tioga for the City Council to amend Ordinance Number 157, the subdivision ordinance, Section F, 1 and 2.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TIOGA, TEXAS:**

Section 1. That Section F, 1 of Ordinance Number 157, known as the sub-division ordinance is hereby amended to read:

"Fire hydrants shall be placed on block corners or near the center of the block to place all of every lot within 500 feet of a fire hydrant in residential and agricultural zoned areas. Where fire hydrants are placed in the interior of the block, they shall be located in alignment with the property line between adjoining lots."

Section 2. That Section F, 2 of Ordinance Number 157, known as the sub-division ordinance is hereby amended to read:

"Fire hydrants shall be located in commercial, industrial, multi-family and mobile home districts so that all of every lot is within 250 feet of a fire hydrant."

Section 3. That if any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance is, for any reason, held to be unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance. The City Council hereby declares that it would have passed this ordinance, and each section, subsection, clause or phrase thereof, irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, sentences, clauses and phrases be declared unconstitutional.

Section 5. That the City Secretary is hereby ordered and directed to cause this ordinance to be published by publishing the caption in a newspaper of general circulation.

Section 6. That this ordinance and the rules, regulations, provisions, requirements, orders and matters established and adopted hereby shall take effect and be in full force and effect immediately from and after the date of its final passage and adoption.
