4. **PUBLIC HEARING TO RECEIVE COMMENT REGARDING THE BUDGET PROPOSED FOR THE 2014-2015 FISCAL YEAR. THIS BUDGET WILL RAISE MORE REVENUE FROM PROPERTY TAXES THAN LAST YEAR'S BUDGET BY AN AMOUNT OF \$9,725, WHICH IS A 3.05 PERCENT INCREASE FROM LAST YEARS BUDGET. THE PROPERTY TAX REVENUE TO BE RAISED FROM NEW PROPERTY ADDED TO THE TAX ROLL THIS YEAR IS \$3,895.**

6. Discuss and consider approving expenditures for the month of August 2014. Possible action.
7. Review Departmental Reports on work activities conducted during August, 2014; no action required.
8. Discuss approval of an application filed in 2012/13 for a \$200,000 TxCDBG award in support of water and sewer system improvements. Possible Action.
9. Discuss and consider possible action regarding 2015/16 TxCDBG application cycle. Possible Action.
10. Review Public Funds Investment Policy and discuss and consider approving resolution number 113 renewing the policy for the 2014-2015 fiscal year. Possible Action.
11. Discuss and Consider approving Ordinance number 321, making appropriations for the support of the City of Tioga for the Fiscal year beginning on October 1, 2014; appropriating the money into a sinking fund to pay interest and principal due to the city's indebtedness; and adopting the annual budget for the 2014-2015 fiscal year. **This Budget will raise revenue from property taxes than last year's budget by an amount of \$9725, which is a 3.05 percent increase from last years budget. The property tax revenue to be raised from new property added to the tax roll this year is \$3895.** Possible Action.
12. Discuss and Consider approving Ordinance number 322, levying ad valorem taxes for use and support of the municipal government of the City of Tioga, for the 2014-2015 fiscal year; setting ad valorem taxes for use and support of the municipal government of the City of Tioga for the 2014-2015 fiscal year; setting a tax rate of \$.562945/\$100; providing for apportioning each levy for specific purposes; and providing when taxes shall become due and when same shall become delinquent if not paid. Possible Action.
13. Discuss and consider ratifying the property tax revenue increase reflected in the budget. Possible Action.
14. Discuss and consider approving Ordinance number 323, providing for water rates for the City of Tioga Water System; establishing a schedule of fees for water usage inside and outside the city limits of the City of Tioga; repealing Ordinance 316; providing for authority to enforce the ordinance; providing for severability; providing for repeal; providing for publication; providing for engrossment and enrollment; and providing an effective date. Possible Action.
15. Discuss and consider approving Ordinance number 324, providing for new sewer rates for residential and commercial customers of the City of Tioga, repeals Ordinance number 278 and any other ordinances in conflict with this ordinance, establishing the base rates for both residential and commercial sewer service in the City of Tioga; and providing for an effective date. Possible Action.




