

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE FIRING OR EXPLODING OF FIREWORKS, PROVIDING FOR SPECIAL DAYS AND CONTROL OF SAID FIREWORKS AND PROHIBITING THE SALE OF SAID FIREWORKS OR EXPLODING MATERIAL , AND PROVIDING FOR PENALTY FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TIOGA, TEXAS:

Section 1: The City Council having deemed that it would be for the welfare and benefit of the residents of the City of Tioga for the firing or exploding of fireworks to be controlled, and that said fireworks may only be exploded upon certain holidays or occasions as herein set forth.

Section 2: That it shall be unlawful to set off fireworks or explode fireworks within the city limits or within the City of Tioga except upon certain special occasions or holidays when same may be used for a public display of fireworks for the entertainment or celebration of the community or citizens of the City of Tioga. That such fireworks display shall only be under the supervision of professional fireworks display specialists, and then only with fire department or police control and protection, and when such protection is immediately available for protecting the community and property from any fire that might issue from said fireworks display.

Section 3: That the use of or the firing, exploding of all fireworks or of any other material or combination of materials that would ignite or cause an explosion or be utilized for the entertainment or self-satisfaction of individuals or cause other parties to be startled, annoyed, or damaged, by said explosion is hereby prohibited.

Section 4: That the sale of all fireworks, dynamite or any other exploding materials within the city limits of Tioga, Grayson County, Texas, is hereby prohibited.

Section 5: That any person, group of persons or corporation violating this ordinance may be charged with a fine of \$1.00 to \$100.00.
