

ORDINANCE NO. 76

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING GARAGE SALES IN RESIDENTIAL AREAS, LIMITING NUMBER PER YEAR, PROVIDING FOR NO COST, CONTROL OF ADVERTISING TO OWN PROPERTY, REPEALING ANY ORDINANCE IN CONFLICT AND DECLARING IT AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TIOGA:

SECTION I: Whereas, the City Council finds that there are numerous garage sales being held in residential sections and in order to control the public health and welfare there is a necessity to pass an Ordinance in the control of said sales; this Ordinance shall amend Ordinance # 75 which was passed on July 14, 1986.

SECTION II: That after the passage of this Ordinance, individual residents shall not hold more than four (4) garage sales per year with each such sale not exceeding three consecutive days in length. The said residents shall secure a permit, for which there will not be a charge, from the City Clerk for each sale.

SECTION III: From passage of this Ordinance, no residents shall hold a garage sale and advertise the said sale, except by signs on their own property, without having evidence of permission from the owner of the said property on which they placed signs.

SECTION IV: That violation of this Ordinance shall be by fine of not less than \$10.00 nor more than \$100.00 for each violation. All ordinances in conflict are hereby repealed.

SECTION V: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon passage. An emergency is declared by the City Council to protect the public welfare.
