

ORDINANCE NO. 376

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF TIOGA, TEXAS ESTABLISHING RATES FOR BULK WATER SERVICE IN THE CITY OF TIOGA AND FOR ALL CUSTOMERS OF THE CITY OF TIOGA WATER SYSTEM, BOTH INSIDE AND OUTSIDE THE CITY LIMITS OF THE CITY OF TIOGA; ESTABLISHING BULK WATER SERVICE DEPOSIT FEE; ESTABLISHING BULK WATER METER RENTAL FEE; PROVIDING FOR THE PUBLICATION OF THE CAPTION OF THIS ORDINANCE; PROVIDING FOR A SECTION REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT WITH THIS ORDINANCE; SETTING AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, The City Council of the City of Tioga has determined that certain charges for water service should be created in order to maintain the health, safety, and welfare of the water system of the City of Tioga; and

WHEREAS, The City of Tioga requires deposits for certain utility service accounts for utility service in the City of Tioga; and

WHEREAS, the demand for a safe, secure and dependable water system for the city requires that fees be created periodically; and

WHEREAS, The City Council of the City of Tioga has determined that certain fees need to be created to reflect current costs;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Tioga, Texas:

SECTION ONE. RATES ESTABLISHED.

A water use fee of \$11.70 per one thousand (1,000) gallons will be charges for all bulk water sales for all customers of the City of Tioga, both inside and outside the city limits of the City of Tioga.

SECTION TWO. FEES ESTABLISHED

- A. A fee for bulk water service deposits is hereby established to the One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000) for all customers of the City of Tioga both inside and outside the city limits.
- B. A rental fee for a fire hydrant type meter is hereby established to be Ten Dollars (\$10.00) per day or Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$250.00) per month.

SECTION THREE. PUBLICATION

The Caption of this Ordinance shall be published one (1) time in the Whitesboro News Record, a newspaper having a general circulation in the City of Tioga, Texas.


SECTION FOUR. REPEALER
