Discuss and consider approving City Ordinance number 384, establishing the speed limits for traffic in and near the Tioga Elementary-Middle School during the time school is in session and designating the portion of the streets near the Tioga Elementary-Middle School that shall be subject to the reduced speed limit while school is in session; making it unlawful for any person to exceed the posted speed limit in a motor vehicle; providing a penalty for violation of this ordinance. Possible action
12. Discuss and consider adopting a new compliment of codes (building, electrical, plumbing, fire, etc.) Possible action.
13. Discuss and consider closing City Hall and allowing city employees to be off on Friday, July 5, 2019. Possible action.
14. Canvass votes and declare results of the general election held May 4, 2019 for the purpose of electing a mayor and two council members to two-year terms and declare results. Possible action.

15. Discuss and consider entering into a development agreement with Nathan Brown for his development project on Lamar Street. Possible Action.


1. *Items marked with an * are consent items considered to be non-controversial and will be voted on in one motion unless a council member asks for separate discussion.*
