City Council Regular Meeting
April 13, 2020

Call to order and declaration of a quorum. Mayor Craig Jezek called the meeting to order at 7:03 p.m. Council members Heather Nesmith, Kurt Hall, Tommy Hunter and Mead McGee were present; Jeff Moncrief was absent. A quorum was declared.

Invocation. Mead McGee led those present in prayer.

Questions or comments regarding agenda items. No questions or comments were offered.

Departmental Reports on work activities conducted during March 2020.** The City Council reviewed written reports on work activity conducted during April, 2020. No discussion was held.


